

ISHA Year End High Point Arabian Horse Competition

Sponsored by the Indiana Arabian Horse Club

Beginning in 2021, The Indiana Arabian Horse Club will sponsor the ISHA Year End High Point Arabian Horse Competition. The purpose of the competition is to spotlight the versatility of the Arabian horse. Award will be presented at the ISHA Year End Awards Banquet. Criteria to compete in the competition is as follows:

- Must be an ISHA member in good standing - dues paid for current year
- Based on **ONE** Nominated Horse/Exhibitor combination
- Each Horse/Exhibitor combination requires a completed nomination form: competition nomination fee is \$5 per Horse/Exhibitor combination
- Points are earned at either the ISHA Spring, or Fall Open All Breed Horse Show or both
- **The nominated Horse/Exhibitor combination must enter an Arabian specific halter class: #5 Arabian Halter-Mares, or #9 Arabian Halter-Geldings or #67 Arabian Halter-Stallions**
- **Additionally, the nominated Horse/Exhibitor combination must enter one of the following Saddle Type Performance classes: #31 Saddle Type All Breeds Country or English Pleasure: W/T/C or #33 Saddle Type All Breeds Hunter: W/T/C or #44 Saddle Type All Breeds Western Pleasure: W/J/L or #81 Arabian/Half Arabian Native Costume: W/C/HG.**
- Must enter the required Arabian halter class and required Saddle Type performance class (see specified classes above) at each show or both shows (not combination of shows)
- Points earned in all other classes will be added to the point total from the Arabian Halter and Saddle Type specified Performance class combination
- Points are calculated by the number of horses in the class, maximum 6 points per class
